Then the bubble burst as the visitors once again showed the ugly face of football deliberately kicking and knocking down a Towers player whilst the match official was unsighted but right in front of the visitors own linesman, Towers supporters and manager. Then when it looked like a draw was likely the seemingly obligatory extended second half, this week just 52 minutes long, dragged on with the visitors snatching the winner right at the death.
