Ristee Towers FC ended this game disappointed that they did not get the full three points but had to settle for a home draw and 4th place in the division. The pitch had been dried in part by the permanent natural hairdryer effect of the home Woodford pitch but was treacle like in parts so mistakes and tiredness were to be expected from both sides. Towers started off facing uphill into the strong headwind and again did well to keep visitors out to concede just the one goal in the first half. A half time chat, a quick tactical switch and within a minute Towers were level having poured into the area to attack in force and be given a penalty from a handball decision. Shaun Wesley stepped up and banged the ball low into the bottom corner. Towers pressed on until Kevin Davis, free at last from his marathon stand in as keeper, took a free kick straight to Mark Seaman for his headed finish at 57 minutes. And so the charge went on with the visitors taking the rare run up the other end until Towers came unglued from their own throw in to let Grange in for a cross to an unmarked player in the box who levelled the score on 83 minutes.
