Suddenly it was all Towers as Adam Taylor passed the ball back from a free kick to Jimmy Randall who drilled it in on 11 minutes from 25 yards. Despite all the pressure that was looking like the half time score until Gary Rose pounced on a scuffed clearance which he crossed to Sean Wesley to head in on 43 minutes. Right on half time some nice link up play between Gary Rose and Sean Wesley placed the ball for Simon Emery to control and score for 4 nil at the break.

Ristee Towers then faced the uphill slog into the wind for the second half and the expected charge from the visitors which never really materialised.
